# Manufacturing

Manufacturing plays a crucial role in the Canadian Economy. Accounting for \$174B of GDP, manufacturing represents 10% of Canada's total GDP. Even more important, this crucial vertical exports more than \$354B a year – 68% of all Canada's merchandise exports<sup>1</sup>.

The giant economic engine that is Canadian manufacturing is powered by people. Over 1.7M² full-time, men and women all across the country. This highly skilled workforce includes people with a variety of training and expertise: designers, engineers, manufacturers, technicians and managers. The labor pool that drives the industry forward isn't cheap, and managers need to do whatever they can to increase productivity and efficiency.

The average absenteeism rate in 2011 was 9.3 days per full-time employee, and over the course of the year, this costs the Canadian economy \$16.6B<sup>2</sup>.

A typical employee visits the washroom 3-4 times a day.<sup>3</sup> For an average building with 100 employees, that's over 146,000 washroom visits per year.<sup>3</sup> 95% of cleaning professionals believe washroom cleaning has an impact on overall public health by helping to prevent the spread of disease.<sup>4</sup>
